Public Release #4.0.16692 Released January 15, 2021

Changes:

- Added {WinSave} and {WinRestore} to the [scripting language](#). These commands allow you to store a window context within a script, then return to that context later in the script.
- Added "Check Now" button for software updates on the Preferences tab of the Options dialog.
- Added {blockinput [on/off]} to the [scripting language](#). This command allows scripts to block user keyboard and mouse input during script operation. If {blockinput on} is included without {blockinput off} keyboard and mouse input will stop being blocked upon completion of script execution.
- Text and Content Substitutions can be reliably sent from a local ActiveWords installation to a remote session window for most remote access solutions such as Microsoft Remote Desktop and CITRIX. Network administrators should be consulted to assure compatible Windows Clipboard security settings between the local and remote environments.
- Fixed a bug where a script calling a context within a script would not act on the changed context.
- Fixed an issue with Scripted text entry, avoiding unwanted or misplaced spaces in the output.
- Fixed crash when closing the List View window when the Last Used column was visible.
- Fixed crash when changing the Hotkey assignments.
- Updated third party components.
- Reliability and speed improvements.
- Fixed crash related to text monitor overflow.
- Fixed crash related to resetting List View Filter then restarting.
- Fixed crash related to checking license dialog.
- Fixed Windows 7 issue when exiting ActiveWords.

- Added a message box to the Scripting language: `_${ShowMessage "title", "message"}`. Use this to pop up a message for the user during a script operation.

- User is now prompted to Edit or Cancel when Saving a newly created Action that already exists.

Changes:

- Fixed issue in an Outlook email view where backspaces were sent when triggering an Action resulting in messages being sent to the Archive folder (this is an Outlook "feature" that required ActiveWords to be aware of the current specific context).
- Keyboard response improved with large databases.
- Using the Tab key to move between fields in the List View is improved.
- You can now use the arrow keys to navigate up and down the search filter list in the List View.
- Pressing the Esc key while the focus is on the search filter list now returns you to the top level of the search filter where you can use Tab to move between fields.
- The above three fixes allow scripting of complex List View searches.
- Fixed issue with the right shift key and Sticky Keys.
- Other behind the scenes fixes.

- Added more prominent border on Pick Lists.

- Fixed an issue where files, folders, and programs opened by an ActiveWord Action would not consistently become the foreground window.

Changes:

- You can now control how paste is delivered in a Substitute Content Action: Keep Source Formatting, Keep Text Only, Merge Formatting, or Use Destination Styles. Click the icon that appears after pasting to change the paste format.
- You can now use Windows environment variables in Open URL Actions, for example, `https://%[environmentvariable]%.mysites.com/`.

Changes:

- Added Help button to initial startup dialog.
- Fixed issue that was causing crashes when a terminal services installation was opened by more than one user.
- Fixed issues when pasting into an Action field.
- Fixed crash when pressing Esc or Ctrl while editing an Action field.
- Fixed issue when using parameters with Launch Program Actions (example: `chrome.exe https://activewords.com`).

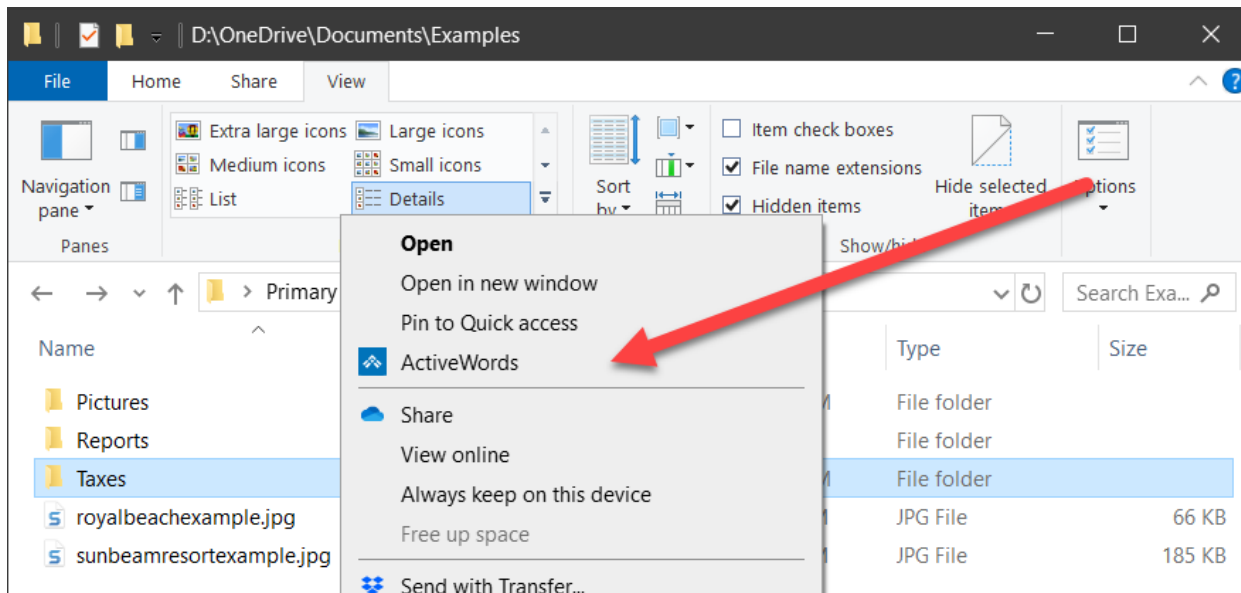
Changes:

New Features:

- Added Windows Explorer Context menu to add Actions. Works for single and multiple objects selected in Windows Explorer.



- ActiveWords now supports multiple monitor configurations. You can position the List View and other windows in the monitor of choice while the Icon and Text Monitor remain bounded to the Primary display.
- ActiveWords can now open Windows Shell objects such as Recycle Bin.
- The ActiveWords Icon and Text Monitor will be automatically hidden on the local device when a window from an application listed in Auto Disable is in focus.
- Network administrators can now control whether [ActiveWords starts with Windows](#) for all users on first run when ActiveWords is run from a server.

Changes:

- When the Caps Lock key is active and you trigger an Action, the Caps Lock key will no longer turn "off."
- Improvements in context awareness to improve text handling.
- Fixed issues related to the License Expiration Warning and License Expired dialogs not automatically popping up.
- Fixed issues with ActiveWords Sync.
- Fixed issues with window and icon position validation for users with multiple monitors.
- Improved logging detail.

New Features and Changes:

- Introducing "[ActionText](#)." You can now act on any text you enter in the ActionPad as well as on selected text. ActiveWords now serves as your front end for accessing information and resources in your work and personal environments. Two "ActionText" look ups are now included in the default installation (Bing and DuckDuckGo). You can delete these and add your own. [See video](#).
- Reconfigured Options to include the Hotkeys tab for enabling the ActiveWords Key, ActionPad, TextMonitor on/off toggle, and to clear and reset the Text Monitor. [See video](#).
- Improved handling of text entered after triggering substitutions.
- Improved reliability of restoring the clipboard after pasting substitutions. Windows Clipboard contents will be restored after triggering a Word as the default behavior.
- Improved substitution speed by reducing the default length of Substitute Text Actions using the Windows Clipboard.
- Improved behavior of Text Monitor and Action Pad when at the edge of the screen.
- You can now customize the Text Monitor text and background colors to specific RGB/HTML values.
- The ActiveWords System Tray icon is now consistent with Windows 10 "Fluid Design" standards.
- The `$(input)` command now accepts a blank prompt and/or title, as in: `$(input "", "")`.

Changes:

- Fixes a crash when starting a new log file.
- Fixes a crash when unable to save a license file.
- Mouse click will now trigger ActionText selection list.
- Fixed issue with Caps Lock and Shift keys.
- Modified interaction with Windows keyboard code to improve reliability.
- Fixed an occasional problem where starting ActiveWords after running the installer would fail to handle the database properly.
- Fixed an issue related to pressing the "Esc" key when ActiveWords was running.
- Restored functionality of the "Make substitutions case sensitive" control in the "Preferences" tab of the "Options" dialog.
- Clarified error message if the ActiveWords database can't open because it is already open and is being written to.
- Fixed an issue where ActiveWords would not recognize keyboard input when Windows was Unlocked or brought out of Sleep or Hibernation.
- The function key F10 can now be used as a Hotkey.
- Display of the Action Description in the Text Monitor is now more appropriate in certain cases.
- The "Clear and reset the Text Monitor" control now clears the Text Monitor when its Hotkey is pressed (and prevents any previously entered Word from triggering). If "t"="the " then "t[Hotkey] "="t ".
- Fixed issues with some of the "win" scripting commands and made the syntax more flexible as to placement of spaces.

Changes:

- Opening a "*.awbak" file will now start the Restore process.
- Productivity data is now calculated as [documented](#). Productivity data prior to installation of this build will be deleted. New productivity data will be captured beginning on the installation date of this build, and will be summarized in the Productivity dialog starting 5 days after installation.

New Features and Changes:

- Added Trigger = "None" when adding or editing a Word. With the Trigger set to "None" the Word will trigger the related Action only within the ActionPad (if enabled) or by using the ActiveWords Key (default is F8). The Action Description will continue to appear in the Text Monitor when the Word is entered.
- If you start ActiveWords 4 when ActiveWords 3 is running, a dialog now better clarifies the circumstances.

Changes:

- Clicking the ActiveWords Start Menu icon when ActiveWords is already open will now open the List View, rather than display an empty dialog.
- ActiveWords should no longer crash when launching an application file fails.
- Resolved instances where the installer would fail to complete.
